



## AI & SUSTAINABILITY IN VET EDUCATION

International Project Meeting Held in Skopje

The international project meeting of the Erasmus+ KA220-VET project "AI & Sustainability in VET Education (AISVE)" (Project No. 2023-1-LT01-KA220-VET-000155506) was successfully held on 20–21 April in Skopje, North Macedonia.

The project is coordinated by Kaunas University of Technology (Lithuania), with SETUGS "Mihajlo Pupin" as one of the project partners.

The meeting was hosted by SETUGS "Mihajlo Pupin". The event was officially opened by the School Principal, Dimitar Gjorgjiev, who welcomed the project consortium and emphasized the importance of Erasmus+ projects in strengthening international cooperation, promoting the exchange of knowledge and good practices, and bringing together people from different cultures. In his opening remarks, he highlighted the growing role of Artificial Intelligence and sustainability in vocational education and the importance of equipping learners and teachers with the skills needed for the future.

Following the opening address, Angjelka Andreski welcomed the partners and presented the agenda and objectives of the two-day meeting. She underlined the significance of the AISVE project and the positive impact it has already had, not only within SETUGS "Mihajlo Pupin" but also across vocational education and training (VET) schools in North Macedonia by promoting innovation, digital transformation, and sustainable practices.



### Status of Work Packages and Project Updates

The AI-SAVES partnership continues to make steady progress across all work packages, with important milestones being achieved as the project moves toward its final implementation phase.







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### WP2 – Capacity Training for Teachers

The development of the AI-SAVES@VET MOOC platform is progressing successfully, with strong participation from VET teachers across the partner countries. Project-based learning activities have generated a significant number of innovative submissions, while certification of participants is continuing.

Partners discussed the importance of following up with teachers who have not yet completed all course requirements, particularly the final quizzes and assessment activities. Additional support will be provided where needed to ensure that all eligible participants successfully complete the training and receive their certificates before the end of the project.

The competition will recognize both national and international winners, encouraging collaboration, creativity, and innovation among participating students and teachers.

### WP5 – Communication, Dissemination and Exploitation

Communication and dissemination activities continue according to plan. Partners are organizing national replication workshops to present project results, engage relevant stakeholders, and promote participation in the international competition.

The videos will be published gradually on the project's communication channels, ensuring continuous visibility of project achievements and good practices throughout the final months of implementation. Overall, the consortium remains fully committed to achieving the project's objectives. The upcoming period will focus on completing teacher training, publishing educational resources, launching the international competition, and maximizing the visibility and long-term impact of the AI-SAVES project.
